1. Disregard deemed income of parents in determining eligibility for pregnant women under 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(IV) and 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(IX) of the Act.
2. In determining eligibility for pregnant women and infants under age 1, as referenced under Section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(IX), disregard the difference between 185% and 200% of the Federal Poverty Level by family size as revised annually in the Federal Register.
3. In determining eligibility for children under age 21 for whom kinship guardianship assistance payments are made on behalf of or who are receiving foster care and are in the care and custody of the local social services district commissioner or in the care and custody of the Commissioner of the Office of Children and Family Services, as authorized by Sections 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(I) and 1905(a)(i) of the Act and by 42 CFR Section 435.222(b)(1) and as described in Attachment 2.2-A, page 13, paragraph B.(b)(1)(d), disregard all income.]

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
